St. Patrick's Day Tea
6" finished, 6 1/2" unfinished

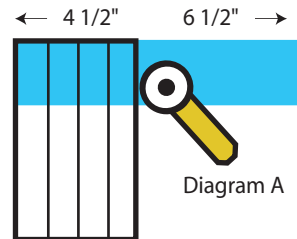
Fabric Requirements:

- One 2 1/2" x 11" strip of white on white fabric
- One 2 1/2" x 11" strip of green fabric.

Cutting instructions:

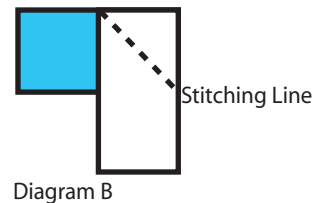
With the right sides together, lay the white on white fabric strip on top of the green strip.

Lay your ruler on the strips with the 4 1/2" mark on the edge. Cut strips into 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" and 2 1/2" x 6 1/2" segments. (Diagram A)



Piecing Instructions:

Using the two 2 1/2 x 4 1/2" segments, place the white on white fabric at a 90 degree angle to the top right side of the green strip. Draw a line on the diagonal. (Diagram B)



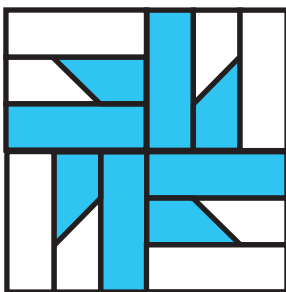
Sew along the line, trim and press towards the green.

Lay out the pieces as follows. Dark strip-pieced strip with the shorter darker side adjacent to the dark piece-white on white piece. (Diagram C)



Piece block. Press towards darker seams.

Look how good these blocks look arranged in this spinning configuration. Of course, there are several ways to arrange them but this is my favorite. We'll let the winner decide.
